

## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

## **Medical English for MDs**

- is a 48-hour ONLINE course held once a week on Monday evenings and on a Wednesday evening once a month
- is organized by Istanbul Medical Chamber with experienced English Language instructors
- aims to develop English communication skills on patient-doctor communication
- aims to develop language, vocabulary, reading and writing skills and strategies through medical articles
- aims to develop listening and presentation skills for medical conferences
- involves a variety of materials from different sources
- requires its participants to actively get involved in the class activities and discussions
- requires its participants to get prepared before the classes and to practice with assignments after the classes
- aims to equip the participants with **self study skills** that will be necessary in their future academic/professional studies.

## **COURSE OUTCOMES & SKILLS**

- communicate with patients on patient history, diagnosis and treatment
- read and analyze academic texts from medical literatüre
- identify frequently used language structures and develop vocabulary strategies

- write abstacts for medical articles
- listen and take notes from medical conferences/seminars/lectures
- prepare and deliver presentations
